Press Powell was first a vocational agriculture teacher and then a private business owner, as well as a supporting member of the FFA Parent Booster Club at Chico Senior High School. He greatly believed in the Future Farmers of America (FFA) organization and its support of our youth. The Chico FFA Booster Club created an opportunity for Chico Chapter senior student members to apply for a scholarship that would enable the recipients to further themselves in their career and life goals.

The scholarship will be awarded at the annual Chico High School FFA Chapter Banquet or the annual Senior Awards night.

Requirements

Application:

You may duplicate this application on your computer. Standard margins, Times New Roman, 12 point, not to exceed three (3) pages. On items D through I you must list your responses by year/grade (i.e.: Freshman, Sophomore, Junior, and Senior).

Essay Requirement:

Include a maximum of one (1) page essay explaining what you have done and what you plan to do to accomplish your career goals in the future. Attach to the back of the application.

References:

Submit two (2) letters of reference. Attach to the back of the application behind your essay.
